
letter travel half way around the world using 6 modes of transportation all while Franked by a Duck Stamp which was not valid for postage. We just love the stories we can tell through mail!"

"Centennial of Rural Free Delivery Issue. The establishment of Rural Free Delivery in the United States spawned easier access for rural families to communicate beyond the farm and connect to the modern world. The new service began as an experiment in 1896 and became an official nation-wide service in 1902, creating a new commercial market. The Postal Service commemorated the 100th anniversary of Rural Free Delivery with the issuance of a 32-cent stamp on August 7, 1996. Mail was able to connect families across the nation and still continues to today!"
